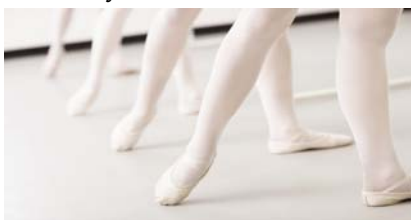
### WELCOME
